**MEETINGS**

It was agreed that committee meetings were not necessary

**FINANCIAL REPORT**

Available funds were £4,238.01.

It was agreed that the year end would be 30<sup>th</sup> April each year.

Income in the current year was £520 subscriptions and £157 social event. Expenditure in the current year was £800 on rent, £200 on insurance and £180 on ARA membership.

It was calculated that we needed £1,500 income in order to stay solvent in a year

In October we would need to account to the Awards for All as to the use of their £5,000 grant.

Peter would find a non member who would audit the accounts for us each year

Zig Zag Quarries and Heathfield Landfill had replied to Alan's letter suggesting sponsorship and were in conversation with him.

### **EXPENDITURE PLANS**

It was decided not to purchase the Christ Church IV as it did not split. Alan and Martin would research a Yanousek split IV for £1,600

Alan had purchased seats for the Quad which was now nearly ready with just the slides to adjust.

Exeter had some Concept 2 carbon fibre blades for £50 - agreed to purchase

The Training Tub was almost finished and looking good. To be used on the Open Day. It was agreed that we would risk mooring it on the beach so that members could use without an army of lifters required.

### **SUBSCRIPTIONS**

It was agreed that the following levels of subscription would apply for the year ended April 30<sup>th</sup> 2008:-

Single membership	£35 plus ARA capitation of £5	= £40
Couple membership	£50 plus ARA capitation of £5	= £60
Additional family	£10 each plus ARA capitation of £5	= £15 each

### **SUMMER ROWING**

In principle the club would like to boat at every tide opportunity but it was recognised that availability of coxes was the limitation. We would attempt to run the full set to start with.

A discussion about safety and qualifications of a coach/cox ensued. It was agreed that Mike Bryant could act as a cox. Peter Brunt has volunteered to drive the safety boat three times per month. Alan to chase up safety boat course.

Alan, Youlie and Peter were acting on publicity for the Open Day. Les would provide meat and BBQ food. Everyone is asked to bring what you can eat plus enough for four and some drink
